

Privacy statement

1. Introduction

This privacy statement applies to every agreement that is entered into with you as a client and a lawyer of DH Legal (hereinafter referred to as lawyer), c.q. DH Legal for products and services of the Product Platform, respectively. This privacy statement is available on the website of DH Legal (www.dh-legal.nl).

DH Legal respects your personal data and ensures that your personal information that you provide to us or that we otherwise obtain is treated confidentially. Personal data is all information about a person. Information that indirectly says something about you is also personal data. With the following, DH Legal complies with its obligation to provide information in accordance with the Dutch General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR), such as the rights of the client whose personal data are being processed by DH Legal.

2. Communication

DH Legal processes personal data to be able to offer services and products, to improve services and to communicate with you personally. DH Legal often engages a third party to evaluate our services. As a client, you make the choice yourself whether or not to leave your personal data for this.

3. Purpose of processing personal data

DH Legal processes the personal data mentioned below exclusively for the purposes mentioned below:

- Providing legal services, in particular in the field of financial law (and within that with an extra focus on startups, scale-ups and spin-offs via the Product Platform)
- Conducting (court) proceedings
- Collecting invoices
- Providing guidance, counselling, and referral
- Marketing and communication activities
- Recruiting and selecting (applications)

4. Personal data

DH Legal processes your personal data for the provision of the services. These are the personal data provided by you as a client on your own initiative, or obtained in the context of our services, made known to us by third parties, including counterparties, or have become known through public sources.

This means that DH Legal will only process your personal data on the basis of the following standards, as referred to in article 6 GDPR:

- Legal obligation

- Execution of an agreement
- Consent of the parties concerned
- Legitimate interest

DH Legal only shares your personal data with third parties insofar as necessary for the provision of services with due observance of the aforementioned purposes. This could include the handling by another lawyer on behalf of client's lawyer, having an expert investigation carried out or engaging another third party on behalf of client's lawyer, c.q. DH Legal for products and services of the Product Platform, such as an IT-provider, as well as providing personal data in connection with (legal) proceedings or correspondence with the counterparty.

In addition, DH Legal can provide personal data to a third party, such as a supervisory authority or another public authority insofar as there is a legal obligation.

A processing agreement is concluded with the third party that processes your personal data on behalf of DH Legal, as a result of which that third party is also obliged to comply with the GDPR. Third parties engaged by DH Legal who have their own responsibility under GDPR in processing personal data, are therefore also responsible for compliance with GDPR for (further) processing of your personal data. This includes the accountant, civil-law notary, other third party engaged for a second opinion or expert report.

5. Protection of personal data

DH Legal attaches great importance to the security and protection of your personal data and, considering the state of the technique, ensures appropriate technical and organizational measures to guarantee a level of security tailored to the level of risk involved. In the event that DH Legal makes use of services from third parties, such as an IT supplier, DH Legal will make appointments about adequate security measures in the context of the protection of personal data in the processing agreement.

6. Retention periods

DH Legal does not retain personal data in relation to GDFR any longer than required for the aforementioned purposes or is required by law or regulations.

7. Client's privacy rights

You can send a request for access, correction, limitation, objection, data transferability, deletion of your personal data or withdrawal of previous given permission via the contact details below. You will receive a reaction from us within four weeks of receiving your request. There can be circumstances based on which DH Legal cannot or cannot fully comply with your request. This includes the duty of confidentiality of lawyers and statutory retention periods.

To ensure that we provide the relevant personal data to the right person on the basis of your request, we ask you to submit a copy of a valid passport or Idea card with a shielded passport photo and citizen service number (in such a way that only the last three figures are visible) for verification purposes.

DH Legal only handles requests that relate to your own personal data.

8. Use of social media

Buttons and/or links are included on the website to promote or share web pages on social (media) networks or third-party websites, such as Instagram, LinkedIn, YouTube, or Facebook. DH Legal does not supervise and is not responsible for the processing of your personal data by and through such third parties. The use of those media is therefore at your own risk. Before using those third party services, it is advisable to read the privacy statements of those third parties.

9. Statistics and cookies

DH Legal keeps user data of the website(s) for statistical purposes. The personal data collected in this way are, in principle anonymous and are not sold by DH Legal to third parties. In order to increase the user-convenience of the website(s) of DH Legal, so-called 'cookies' are used. A cookie is a small text file that is placed for example on your desktop, laptop, iPad, or smartphone. You can refuse the use of these cookies at any time, although this may limit the functionality and the user-convenience of the website(s).

The website of DH Legal uses cookies from Google Analytics to track user behavior and general trends and to obtain reports. This helps to improve the functioning of the website(s). Google may provide this information to third parties if Google is required to do so by law or insofar as third parties process the information on Google's behalf. By using the website(s) of DH Legal you consent to processing of the information by Google in the manner and for the purpose described above.

Cookies are also placed through the use of buttons and/or links, as described above under 8 'Use of social media'. DH Legal has no influence on the placement and use of cookies by those third parties.
